

ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR SEWAGE DISPOSAL SERVICE AND PROVIDING PROCEDURES FOR ITS ENFORCEMENT"

SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, California, as follows:

Section 1. Article VIII. of Ordinance No. 16, entitled "An Ordinance Establishing Rates and Charges for Sewage Disposal Service and Providing Procedures for Its Enforcement," passed and adopted August 10, 1972, as amended, is hereby amended by amending Section 70 thereof, to read as follows:

70. Rate Schedule. Sewer service charges are hereby established as follows:

<u>Service Charges</u>	<u>Charge Per Month</u>
1. <del>Multiple</del> <sup>Single</sup> family dwelling	2.00
2. Multiple family dwellings, duplexes, flats and apartments	2.00/unit
3. Auto courts, motels, trailer parks	1.00/unit
4. Office buildings, hotels, rooming house: First unit	2.00
Each additional unit	.80
5. Commercial houses, schools, churches: First fixture	2.00
Each additional toilet, urinal, shower, launderette unit, restaurant, sink, dishwasher, wash rack, etc.	.80
6. Industrial, business, laundries, launderettes, restaurants, bars, theatres, service stations, garages, chemical plants	2.00 Min. Plus .24 per 100 cu.ft. of water used in excess of 1000 cu.ft.

The District shall have the option of charging all large users on the basis of volume of sewage discharged into the sewer system.

The metered discharge from those pumps having a final discharge into the sewer system shall be charged on the same basis as metered water furnished by the District.

For any business or occupancy not listed, the charge shall be in such amount as may be established by District, by motion, resolution or ordinance.

District shall have the option of providing sewer service outside the boundaries of District on the basis of charges to be established by special sewer service agreement.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect July 1, 1974.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

## MEMORANDUM

BY MR. Morton

At the meeting of June 12, 1975, Roger Grimsley, the City Manager of Hollister, pointed out that there has been some problem in regard to developers, contractors, street maintenance crews and others taking water from fire hydrants without obtaining a permit and without metering the quantity of water taken and in some instances damaging the meters and the water systems by utilization of improper methods of shutting the hydrants off.

The City Manager indicated that he was investigating the installation of both portable and permanent meter installations to measure the flow taken by contractors, subdividers and others and expected to establish a deposit as a condition of the issuance of the permit to protect the City and to provide for repair of any damage to City equipment. Randolph Churchill stated that the District did have a 2½ inch hydrant meter which was used occasionally on trucks but was used primarily to measure flows taken for irrigation purposes. Randolph Churchill stated that the practice which he had inherited from Herb Bengard was to require the people taking water from hydrants to provide him with the number of loads taken and the number of capacity of vehicles taking each load.
