

ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE ALTERING BOUNDARIES OF  
SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

ANNEXATION NO. 1955-1

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, California, as follows:

1. That a petition signed and acknowledged by the holders of title, or evidence of title, to all of the land described therein according to the last equalized assessment roll of the County of San Benito, together with a particular description of the land proposed to be annexed, was filed with the Secretary of said District on the 12th day of January, 1956, which petition prayed that said lands be added to the District in accordance with the provisions of the County Water District Law.
2. That the Secretary of said District duly set a date for the hearing of said petition and caused to be published in the Hollister Evening Free Lance, a newspaper printed and published in the County of San Benito, a notice stating the purpose of the petition, describing the lands to be added and notifying all persons interested of the hearing thereon to be held on Thursday, February 9, 1956, at 7:30 o'clock P. M. at the regular meeting place of the Board of Directors of said District, at the office of said District, 530 San Benito Street, Hollister, California, the affidavit of which publication has been presented to and is on file with this Board, and that said petition and said notice so published are in the form required by said Law.
3. That at the time and place fixed for said hearing the Board of Directors found and determined pursuant to Resolution No. 17 Prescribing Conditions for Inclusion of Territory and Providing for Hearing Thereon that the inclusion should be made subject to certain conditions, as follows:

(a) The Board of Directors of the District may establish and collect charges on each of the lands proposed to be included in an amount which equals the amount which would have been chargeable as District taxes against said lands had they been on the District tax roll for the fiscal year 1955-1956, together with a similar amount in lieu of taxes which may hereafter be fixed by the District for the fiscal year 1956-1957, and together with a pro rata share of the cost of the proceedings for the annexation of said territory to the District; or

(b) The District may provide for the payment of special taxes within the area proposed to be included in the District until the amounts, as determined pursuant to subdivision (a) hereof, have been levied in full.

4. That at the time and place fixed for said hearing and pursuant to said Resolution No. 17 the hearing on the proposed inclusion of territory was adjourned to Thursday, the 15th day of March, 1956, at 7:30 o'clock P. M., at 530 San Benito Street, Hollister, California, at which time all persons owning property within the territory proposed to be included in the District, shall have an opportunity to submit signed and acknowledged objections to the inclusion of their land subject to the conditions therein stated.

5. That all acts and conditions and things required by law to be done precedent to the hearing of said petition by this Board have been done and have been performed in regular and in due form and in strict compliance with the provisions of the law authorizing the presentation of said petition.

6. That at the time and place fixed in said notice and as fixed in said Resolution No. 17, this Board proceeded to hear

said petition, and the question of imposing conditions upon the inclusion of said lands subject to the terms and conditions, and all written objections thereto and no such objections were received, and upon the hearing of said petition and the terms and conditions, and after a full investigation and examination, this Board has found and declared and does hereby find and declare, that said petition complies with the requirements of the County Water District Law, and this Board does hereby find and declare the addition to the District of the lands proposed to be added subject to said terms and conditions as authorized by said Law and will be for the best interest of the District, and of the lands to be included.

7. That the boundaries of the Sunnyslope County Water District shall be, and they are hereby, altered by adding thereto the hereinafter described territory, which territory is hereby annexed to said District subject to the terms and conditions stated in Section 3 hereof, and the boundaries of which territory so annexed are situate in the County of San Benito, State of California, and are more particularly described in Exhibit "A" hereto attached and by reference incorporated herein.

8. This Ordinance shall be posted in three public places within the District.

EXHIBIT "A"

SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

ANNEXATION NO. 1955-1

BEING a portion of Section 36 in Township 12 South, Range 5 East, M. D. B. & M., and a portion of the Rancho San Justo as shown on map thereof recorded in Book 1 of Maps at page 64, Records of San Benito County, California, and being more particularly described as follows: (Note: Parcel numbers referred to in the following description are the County Assessor's Officially adopted Parcel Numbers)

"BEGINNING at the southeast corner of Section 36 in said Township and Range, being the intersection of the northerly line of Sunnyslope Road with the centerline of the Fairview Road, and running thence northerly along the centerline of the Fairview Road 3696.86 feet, more or less, to the northeasterly corner of the lands of Kenneth Churchill, et ux, as described in deed of record in Volume 184 of Official Records at page 371; thence westerly along the northerly line of said lands of Churchill and the projection thereof to the easterly line of the San Justo Rancho; thence northerly along said Rancho Line to the northeasterly corner of County Assessor's Parcel 20-04-12; thence westerly along the northerly line of said Parcel to the northwesterly corner thereof; thence southerly along the westerly line of said parcel to the northerly line of Hillcrest Road; thence westerly along the northerly line of Hillcrest Road to the intersection thereof with the projected westerly line of Assessor's Parcel 20-12-11; thence southerly along said westerly line to the southwesterly corner of said Parcel; thence easterly along the southerly line thereof to the northwesterly corner of Assessor's Parcel 20-12-30; thence southerly along the westerly line of said Parcel to the northerly line of Sunnyslope Road; thence easterly along the northerly line of Sunnyslope Road to the point of beginning, and also: All of Assessor's Parcels 20-12-2 and 20-04-01, together with all of Hillcrest Road fronting on Parcel No. 20-04-01."
